We also warmly welcome those who have come home to be with their Drimnagh families this Christmas. We hope you make many unique special memories, and your joyful reunion with loved ones is beyond your wildest imaginings.

This Christmas Season, the festival of the family, we will be carrying all those in our Parish, who will have an empty chair or chairs at their table, due to the passing of a loved one in the past year, or because a son or daughter, brother or sister will be away. Our sense of loss or the feeling of absence and the loneliness and worry that can flow from that, reminds us how important and how precious our relationships are at the end of the day.
